Extract from the Constitution

Full Membership

An institution shall be eligible for full membership if:-

The institution provides education and training for personnel in, or intending to join, the Merchant Navy or Fishing Industry

and

The institution offers the total shorebased training requirements for at least one complete MCA (or equivalent) Certificate of Competency and/or one complete MNTB approved maritime award

Associate Membership

Institutions which do not fully meet the criteria for Full Membership but which in the opinion of the Association can promote the interests of maritime education and training, shall be eligible for Associate Membership

When considering applications the Executive Committee and Membership shall, in addition take into account:-

Recognition, if appropriate, by MNTB, SFIA, SQA and MCA in the UK, or their equivalents in other countries, and by relevant Awarding Bodies, as an approved assessment centre for the award of MN and Fishing qualifications and/or Certification. IAMI Executive must be informed of any loss in external recognition or approval by a maritime administration or awarding body.
