





1. Log-on at <https://epa.iami.info/> using your assigned username and password. Your log-in will allow you assess to the apprenticeship standard you are assigned to. If you have been assigned to more than one standard, then you will have multiple logins with different usernames and passwords.
2. The example shows assessor username “pink” logging on and selecting “assessor” in the “select user type.” Note the username entry is case sensitive.





15. You have 50 minutes to complete the oral questioning using the 12 questions assigned to you. Once you have done so, press the “grade” to enter your results. Please do this within 3 days of the EPA.

16. Note that each question you ask has a pass grade and a distinction grade. You are required to use your professional judgement in deciding whether the candidate is at the level of either failed / passed / distinction within the following guidance:

- a. Each EPA professional review will consist of 12 pre-chosen random questions of which the candidate must pass 50% or higher, to gain a **pass grade**.
- b. If only 5 of the questions reach the pass grade, then the candidate has **failed**.
- c. Where over 50% of the answered questions contains answers at the distinction level, AND 75% of the questions have a pass grade, then an overall **distinction grade** will be awarded. For example if 3 questions are failed, 9 questions are passed, and 5 answered at distinction level – final result is distinction.

Each standard has its own specific criteria in what a practical observation contains in terms of:


- a. Duration of practical test

21. In addition to the practical scope listed within the EPA standard, all assessors will be sent the portfolio training record of the candidate. This document was completed by the candidate during their training. You are NOT required to assess or mark this portfolio, but we do ask that you create six questions after reading this portfolio. These questions will allow you to explore areas of the portfolio, via questioning, where you believe the candidate knowledge is weak
